

**Carmen Free-For-All Drawing
Official Rules & Regulations**

No purchase or contribution is necessary to enter the drawing. From the submissions 1100 entrants will each receive two complimentary tickets to the Florida Grand Opera performance of *Carmen* on April 26, 2010. Entrants must sign up at www.FGO.org or send their entry by mail, listing their name, postal address, daytime phone number, and e-mail address on a 3" x 5" card and addressing it to Carmen Ticket Giveaway, c/o Florida Grand Opera, PO Box 561837, Miami, Florida 33256-1837, by midnight on April 5, 2010. Limit one entry per person. Each entry must be mailed separately.

The drawing will occur on April 8, 2010, at the offices of Florida Grand Opera, 8390 NW 25th Street, Miami, Florida 33122. Drawing entrants must be 18 years of age or older.

Restrictions: The drawing will be restricted to those applicants who have not purchased an opera ticket to Florida Grand Opera in the past four seasons.

The winner does not need to be present to win and will be notified via e-mail or telephone. However, if a winner cannot be contacted within 72 hours of the drawing, an alternate winner will be chosen. All prizes will be awarded.
